Volunteer Roles

It wouldn't be possible to run this weekend without the help of our volunteers. We are looking to recruit approximately 25-30 people (aged 16 or over) to help make the event run smoothly and most importantly make sure everyone has a fun time! Roles will include:

- **Artist assistants (team 1)**
 - You will be paired with a specific arts organisation for the day
 - Provide workshop support
 - Welcome visitors, signpost and assist individuals around the event
 - Aid audience participation and generally encourage people to have fun!

- **Event ambassadors (team 2)**
 - This role could either be manning a stall or roaming around the city centre
 - Handing out maps/programmes
 - Answering questions from members of the public
 - Providing directions

- **Production team assistants (team 3)**
 - A vital behind the scenes role
 - Helping with keeping facilities tidy
 - Assisting with set up/moving of equipment
 - Be able to turn a hand to anything should need arise

- To be available to volunteer Saturday 8th and Sunday 9th September 12noon-6pm (or just one of these days)
- To be available to attend a volunteer information session on Tuesday 28th August 6-8pm or Wednesday 29th August 1-3pm (we may be able to be flexible on these dates)

No previous experience is required – We're just looking for reliable, friendly people who enjoy working with the Bradford community. If this sounds like fun to you, then please get in touch asap!
